## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

The City of Greenville is applying to the Ohio Department of Transportation for an operating and capital assistance grant under 49 U.S.C. Section 5311 & 5339 of the Federal Transit Laws, as codified, the Ohio Elderly & Disabled Transit Fare Assistance Program (E&D program), the TIGER discretionary grant and the Ohio Public Transportation Grant Programs.

The operating grant will provide financial assistance for open door, public transportation service for the residents of the City of Greenville, including Family Health Service with limited service in Darke County during CY2018. The city service would operate Monday through Friday 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Fares are \$1.50 for elderly and disabled, \$3.00 for the general public. No notice is needed for city service.

Limited County service available Monday thru Friday 8:00 am to 4:30 pm with fares at the following rates:

Under 1 mile would be city rate plus an additional \$1.00

Zone 1: 1.1 to 3 miles outside city limits at the rate of \$ 5.00 total

Zone 2: 3.1 to 5 miles outside city limits at the rate of \$ 8.00 total

Zone 3: 5.1 to 7 miles outside city limits at the rate of \$12.00 total

Zone 4: 7.1 and over, outside city limits at the rate of \$25.00 total

This service will require a 24-hour notice.

The E&D grant will provide State funds to offset the half fares offered to elderly and disabled passengers.

The capital grant will provide financial assistance to purchase one LTV with lift & capital maintenance for vehicle maintenance and updates to our current security/entry systems. The TIGER grant will provide financial assistance to purchase dispatching hardware and software.

A public hearing will be held at an accessible location at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 18, 2017, in the Council Chambers in the Municipal Building, 100 Public Square, Greenville, Ohio 45331 during the regularly scheduled City Council Meeting, public hearing portion. Note, any request for reasonable accommodations must be received 48 hours in advance.
