Greenville City Pool Rules

1. Violation of general rules or any conduct that may endanger or impair the safety of anyone may be cause for temporary or permanent expulsion from the Greenville City Pool at the discretion of the manager, without refund of fees.
2. Any person caught stealing personal or City property will be permanently expelled from the Greenville City Pool. In addition the City of Greenville may pursue legal prosecution.
3. The Greenville City Pool may close at the discretion of the manager for the following and other justifiable reasons; in the event of inclement weather, i.e. lightning, thunder, or rain; if the temperature drops below 65 degrees; if there are 10 people fewer in the Greenville City Pool complex.
4. Appropriate swimming attire is required in the Pool. No one is permitted to wear jeans, cut offs, khakis, or other street clothes in the Pool. Tee shirts are permitted in the Pool for sunburn protection, only when worn along with appropriate swimming attire. Athletic shorts are acceptable swim attire for males. Athletic shorts worn over proper swim attire are acceptable for females.
5. Greenville City Pool is not responsible or liable for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
6. Lifeguards or any other Pool Staff shall not be distracted from their duties.
7. Running shall not be permitted.
8. Profanity shall not be permitted.
9. Smoking or the use of smokeless tobacco shall not be permitted.
10. Coolers and carry in food and drink are permitted. No alcohol or glass containers are allowed.
11. Patrons shall respect others when swimming, splashing, playing and moving in the pool.
12. No piggy back rides, jumping, spitting, swearing, flipping towels, or littering while in the pool.
13. Only small Nerf or small inflated balls are allowed.
14. Skateboards, basketballs, skates, and other large items are to be left and checked in at the bathhouse. Lock bicycles outside on the rack provided.
15. Public display of affection is prohibited.
16. Diving into the water is only permitted from the boards and no diving from the pool sides.
17. Hanging on the ropes shall not be permitted.
18. Tag is allowed as long as it does not jeopardize the safety of others.
19. The walkway to the acid room, the steep slopes on the east side of the pool area, and the use of hoses are off limits.
20. Music volume should be maintained so as to minimize disturbance to others.
21. Use of the Greenville City Swimming Pool telephone by patrons will be at the discretion of the Pool Staff.
22. Use of the Baby Pool is for children age 6 and under accompanied by a parent or guardian.
23. During restricted swims, only age 21 or greater will be permitted in the water. Restricted swims occur at 10 minutes before each hour to the top of the hour.
24. No Refunds or Rain Checks given of Daily Admissions or Season Passes for any reason including but not limited to pool closing for inclement weather.

Waterslide Rules

1. Rider must be over 3 feet tall and age 3 or greater to ride slide.
2. Swim attire with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets or metal ornamentation, are not allowed on the slide.
3. Only one rider allowed in the flume at a time.
4. Slide must be ridden feet first either seated or lying on back.
5. Rider must wait for the attendants start signal before sliding.
6. Keep arms and hands inside the flume at all times.
7. Do not run, dive, stand, kneel, rotate, or stop in the flume.
8. Rider must exit the slide landing area immediately after sliding.
9. Caution: It is not recommended that patrons, who are pregnant, have heart conditions, or back trouble ride this slide.

Diving Board Rules

1. One person permitted on board at a time.
2. Next diver must wait on deck until board is clear.
3. Before diving, make sure area is clear of swimmers or diver.
4. Make sure previous diver has made it to the exit ladder.
5. Dive straight off end of board.
6. The following are not permitted off the diving board: doubling springing, springing from seated position, hanging from board, cartwheels, handstands, and obscene gestures.
7. After diving, swim directly to the nearest ladder and exit the pool immediately.
8. No one is permitted to catch another person diving off the board.
9. Any person may be required to pass a basic swimming performance test before being permitted to use the diving board.
10. Floatation devices are not permitted to be worn or used when diving off the board.
