#### 2. Bidder Briefing

- a. Instructions to Bidders
  - i. Bids Due Thursday, March 19, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. local time at 100 Public Square, Greenville, Ohio
  - ii. The Engineer's estimate for the project is \$2,059,899.25
  - iii. Time of Substantial Completion October 1, 2020Final / Paperwork Completion November 1, 2020
- b. The bid documents provided shall be used for submission of the bids. The Completed Bid Documents as described in the Instructions to Bidders, along with any necessary additional documents, must be used to submit the bid.
- c. Bids will only be accepted from plan-holders who purchased specifications and plans from the City of Greenville.
- d. The plans/spec book cost is \$46.25. For an additional 24x36 set of plans a 48 hours-notice is required and there is a separate \$65.00 fee.

#### 3. Summary of Work

- a. This project is located in the area of Wagner Avenue
- b. The project consists of widening Wagner Avenue to three lanes and resurfacing the existing roadway from the Walmart parking lot out to Childrens Home Bradford Road. Included in this project is the installation of sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm, sewer, street lighting, pavement

striping ,waterline extensions across Wagner for future tie-in, hydrant legs shortening to place between curb and sidewalk and lower of 12" main in one location.

### 4. Special Requirements

- a. Ohio Prevailing Wages are to be paid.
- b. Katie Benge is the City's Prevailing Wage Coordinator.
- c. Employee interviews to verify wages will be conducted on the job site.
- d. City Income Tax is required to be paid for any work within the City. (1.5% of Medicare wages)
- e. Sales Tax Exemption Certificate: City is exempt from all sales taxes for materials to be incorporated into the work. Exemption Certificate can be obtained from the City Auditor's office.
- f. 100% Bid and Performance Bond(s) are required, per Ohio Revised Code.
- g. Insurance Requirements are listed in Supplementary Conditions Article 6, \$1,000,000 / \$2,000,000.
- h. The City of Greenville is to be named as "additional insured" on the certificate of insurance.

#### 5. Pay Application Requirements

- a. Pay Requests must include the pay request forms in the spec book.
- b. Waiver of Lien
- c. Contractor's Affidavit
- d. Wage reports must be up to date for all workers before any pay request will be processed.
- e. We would like the wage reports on a weekly basis.

## 7. Special issues

- a. Maintain egress to all businesses during construction.
- b. Local traffic to businesses will need to be maintained. Road will be closed to through traffic.
- c. Notify Greenville Water Department minimum 7 days in advance to lowering 12" water main as a shut down will have to occur that effects business in the area.
- d. Notify Greenville Water Department minimum 2 days, prefer 7, in advance toward on hydrants.

## 8. Contractor's Questions – Answers in Red

What is the required connection unfused permanent under 625? Connection per ODOT C&MS 725.15

Where do we include our trenching, backfill and spoils pricing? Per plan note; trenching is incidental to conduit installation.

What is required for the power service? (please supply a detail and specs) ODOT C&MS 625, 725, and SCD HL-40.20.

What size ground rod required? Per ODOT 725.16

What tier should the pull box be? Per ODOT 725.06

What is the required depth of the trenches for the electrical conduit? Per ODOT 625.13 and SCDs HL-20.11 and HL-30.22

Can you supply a cat# for the fused and unfused holder kits? Per ODOT 725.15 and SCD HL-60.12

What is the required backfill in dirt areas and drive areas? Trench per ODOT 625.13 – Drive composition shall be per plan as shown on sheet 4.
