Please read and sign:

- Renters must submit a certificate of liability for 1 Million dollars (\$1,000,000), naming the City of Greenville Parks Department as the certificate holder. (Please contact your home owners insurance agent)
- Swimming Pool must be paid for within 7 days after the reservation is made or such non-payment shall result in the cancellation/forfeiture of the reservation.
- Please contact the Greenville City Swimming Pool at (937)548-3393 before 4:00 pm 24 hours before the day of your reservation if the weather is bad. A decision will be made whether to have the party rescheduled or not.
- An individual, family, club, or organization may reserve the pool. The reserving party must be at least 21 years of age. The reserving party must be present during the entire reserved event and is responsible for the conduct and behavior of those who attend. Reservations made for teens' or children's activities must have at least two (2) parents or guardians present for the entire function.
- Private Pool Party swimmers must obey all pool rules which are presented on page 2 of this form and are also posted at the Pool.
- No admission fee shall be charged to enter the pool.
- It is permissible to serve refreshments at private parties, however, the renting party is responsible for the clean-up of the pool and surrounding area. GLASS CONTAINERS or COOKING is **NOT PERMITTED** in the pool area. Please serve drinks in paper cups or cans and properly dispose of all trash.
- Possession or consumptions of alcoholic beverages on park property or in the pool area is prohibited.
- Private Pool Party swimmers MUST wear proper swim attire. (NO CUT-OFFS).
- Floatation devices are permitted in the pool at management's discretion.

I, _____, (party responsible for rental) have read and understand the rules and regulations governing the use of the above facility and agree to abide by said rules, regulations, and polices. I understand that I, the undersigned, will be held completely and totally responsible for any and all damages that are incurred during the course of the rental and the rental fee in no way limits my liability to the extent of damage. I, the undersigned, also understand that I am responsible for the application of insurance proceeds, if any, to the repair or replacement of the premises or property thereon necessitated by any damages due to negligence, accidents or on purpose, and if not insured, I shall repair the demised premises or replace or repair property thereon solely at my expense.

The City of Greenville Parks and Recreation Department does not assume liability for any injury or death, or loss of personal property to renter or any individual or group associated, employed, or in conjunction with renter on or about the premises, sidewalks or alleys, adjoining the premises for the following circumstances. (1) A loss of property by theft or burglary; (2) Accidental damage to person or property from the use of any utility on the premises; (3) Damage caused by action of the natural elements, or; (4) Damage or injury resulting from the conduct of the employees of renter whether negligent or otherwise. Renter shall not make any claims against the City of Greenville Parks and Recreation Department for any loss or damage described herein. Renter shall also indemnify the Parks and Recreation Department against all claims by any individual group, associate, employee, agent or guest of renter. The City of Greenville Parks and Recreation Department shall be liable for loss, damage, or injury resulting from structural defect of the building on the demised premises if the structural defects are not caused by the negligence of the renter, and renter shall not be obligated to indemnify the City with respect thereto.

The Greenville Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to deny use of the City Parks and facilities to the groups who fail to comply with the rules and regulations set forth by the Greenville Parks and Recreation Department and the City of Greenville. It is understood that the group/organization using the above park/facility will comply with the laws of the State of Ohio, the City of Greenville, and all rules and regulations set forth by the City of Greenville Parks and Recreation Department.

Greenville City Swimming Pool Rules

1. Violation of general rules or any conduct that may endanger or impair the safety of anyone may be cause for temporary or permanent expulsion from the Greenville City Pool at the discretion of the manager, without refund of fees.
2. Any person caught stealing personal or City property will be permanently expelled from the Greenville City Pool. In addition, the City of Greenville may pursue legal prosecution.
3. The Greenville City Pool may close at the discretion of the manager for the following and other justifiable reasons; in the event of inclement weather, i.e. lightning, thunder, or rain; if the temperature drops below 65 degrees; if there are 10 people or fewer in the Greenville City Pool complex.
4. Appropriate swimming attire is required in the Pool. No one is permitted to wear jeans, cut offs, khakis, or other street clothes in the Pool. Tee shirts are permitted in the Pool for sunburn protection, only when worn along with appropriate swimming attire. Athletic shorts are acceptable swim attire for males. Athletic shorts worn over proper swim attire are acceptable for females.
5. Greenville City Pool is not responsible or liable for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
6. Lifeguards or any other Pool Staff shall not be distracted from their duties.
7. Spectators must pay full admission price.
8. Running shall not be permitted.
9. Profanity shall not be permitted.
10. Smoking or the use of smokeless tobacco shall not be permitted.
11. Coolers and carry in food and drink are permitted. No alcohol or glass containers are allowed.
12. Patrons shall respect others when swimming, splashing, playing and moving in the pool.
13. No piggy back rides, jumping, spitting, swearing, flipping towels, or littering while in the pool.
14. Only small Nerf or small inflated balls are allowed.
15. Skateboards, basketballs, skates, and other large items are to be left and checked in at the bathhouse. Lock bicycles outside on the rack provided.
16. Public display of affection is prohibited.
17. Diving into the water is only permitted from the boards and no diving from the pool sides.
18. Hanging on the ropes shall not be permitted.
19. Tag is allowed as long as it does not jeopardize the safety of others.
20. The walkway to the acid room, the steep slopes on the east side of the pool area, and the use of hoses are off limits.
21. Music volume should be maintained so as to minimize disturbance to others.
22. Use of the Greenville City Swimming Pool telephone by patrons will be at the discretion of the Pool Staff.
23. Use of the Baby Pool is for children age 6 and under accompanied by a parent or guardian.
24. During restricted swims, only age 21 or greater will be permitted in the water. Restricted swims occur at 10 minutes before each hour to the top of the hour.
25. No Refunds or Rain Checks given of Daily Admissions or Season Passes for any reason including but not limited to pool closing for inclement weather.

Waterslide Rules

1. Rider must be over 3 feet tall and age 3 or greater to ride slide.
2. Swim attire with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets or metal ornamentation, is not allowed on the slide.
3. Only one rider allowed in the flume at a time.
4. Slide must be ridden feet first either seated or lying on back.
5. Rider must wait for the attendants start signal before sliding.
6. Keep arms and hands inside the flume at all times.
7. Do not run, dive, stand, kneel, rotate, or stop in the flume.
8. Rider must exit the slide landing area immediately after sliding.
9. Caution: It is not recommended that patrons, who are pregnant, have heart conditions, or back trouble, ride this slide.

Diving Board Rules

1. One person permitted on board at a time. Next diver must wait on deck until board is clear
2. Before diving, make sure area is clear of swimmers or diver.
3. Make sure previous diver has made it to the exit ladder.
4. Dive straight off end of board and swim directly to the nearest ladder and exit the pool immediately
5. The following are not permitted off the diving board: doubling springing, springing from seated position, hanging from board, cartwheels, handstands, and obscene gestures.
6. No one is permitted to catch another person diving off the board.
7. Any person may be required to pass a basic swimming performance test before being permitted to use the diving board.
8. Floatation devices are not permitted to be worn or used when diving off the board.
